National Institutes of Health - The NIDA IRP is seeking an outstanding Tenure-Track or Tenure-Eligible Investigator to lead the Neural Computation of Motivation and Decision-Making Section, which is part of the Behavioral Neuroscience Research Branch (BNRB) of the IRP. We are seeking a candidate who is committed to scientific excellence. The successful candidate must use nonhuman primate behavioral models and possess an M.D. and/or Ph.D. or equivalent degrees in pharmacology, neuroscience, or related fields. Criteria for selection include substantial experience in behavioral pharmacology and neuroscience, and a strong publication record on neuropharmacological mechanisms underlying substance use disorders. The successful candidate will be expected to collaborate with other research groups within NIDA (e.g., neuroimaging) and therefore should demonstrate a proven ability to establish and sustain collaborative work across multiple disciplines. INTERNSHIP OPPORTUNITY

Women's Reproductive Health Research (WRHR) scholars are physician-scientists who are receiving funding from the NIH and the Department of Obstetrics, Gynecology and Reproductive Biology for career development. A critical part of becoming a leader in reproductive and sexual health includes providing mentorship for the next generation of physician-scientists. The internship position is an opportunity to work alongside a WRHR scholar over the course of the academic year. It is intended for students who are interested in a health science career, but who have not completed their professional training. Recruited individuals will participate as a critical member of the research team to design study protocols, navigate the institutional review board, interact directly with study participants, analyze data, and contribute to journal manuscripts.
