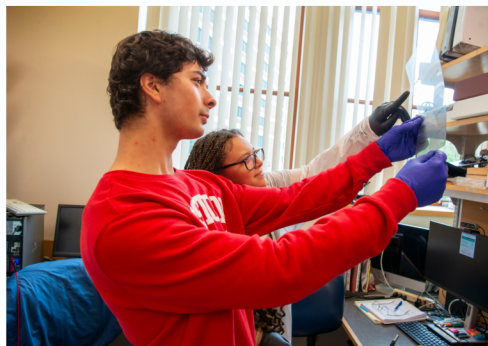


Youth Neurology Education & Research Program

Eligibility

- At the time of program be a rising high school senior, recent high school graduate / rising college first-year, current undergraduate student, or recent college graduate.
- Be living or studying in Massachusetts at the time of program.
- Have an interest in Neurology.
- Be available to work full-time for the duration of the program.
- Be legally authorized to work in the United States.
- Be compliant with Mass General Brigham's occupational health requirements including proof of COVID-19 vaccination.
