Today, they are **facing greater needs and challenges** than any other time in BSCP's history. And the **impact is greatest on those who already face the highest barrier to entry.**

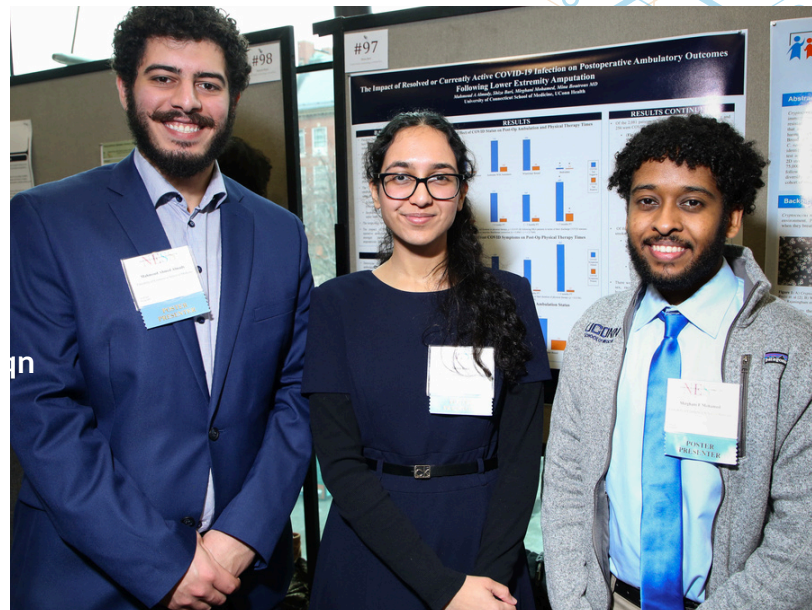
BSCP's Work is More Important Than Ever

Currently **impacting 2,500 students per year**, we hope to double that number by 2035 with even greater geographic representation.

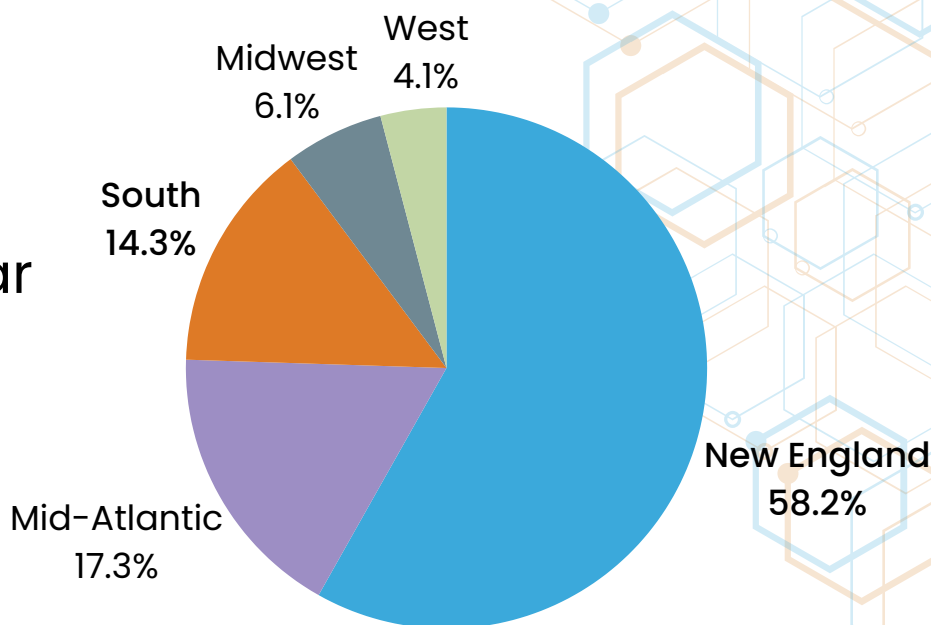

A UNIQUE APPROACH

BSCP offers programs for young people interested in the biomedical sciences, from high school through the postdoctoral level. **Unlike most other organizations, our longitudinal approach** provides students with support throughout their academic journey.

Through initiatives designed to benefit students at each academic level, **BSCP intentionally brings together students from a range of degree programs and experiences.** This unique model provides participants with opportunities for peer-to-peer mentoring as well as connections with students who are further along in their education.

- College students answer questions from high schoolers about the application process.
- Graduate students, from master's to MD candidates, talk to college students about what's next.
- Fellows give PhD and MD candidates inspiration to push through.

By building a personal network of contacts at different academic levels, BSCP participants learn the value of reaching out for support and reaching back to those following in their footsteps.

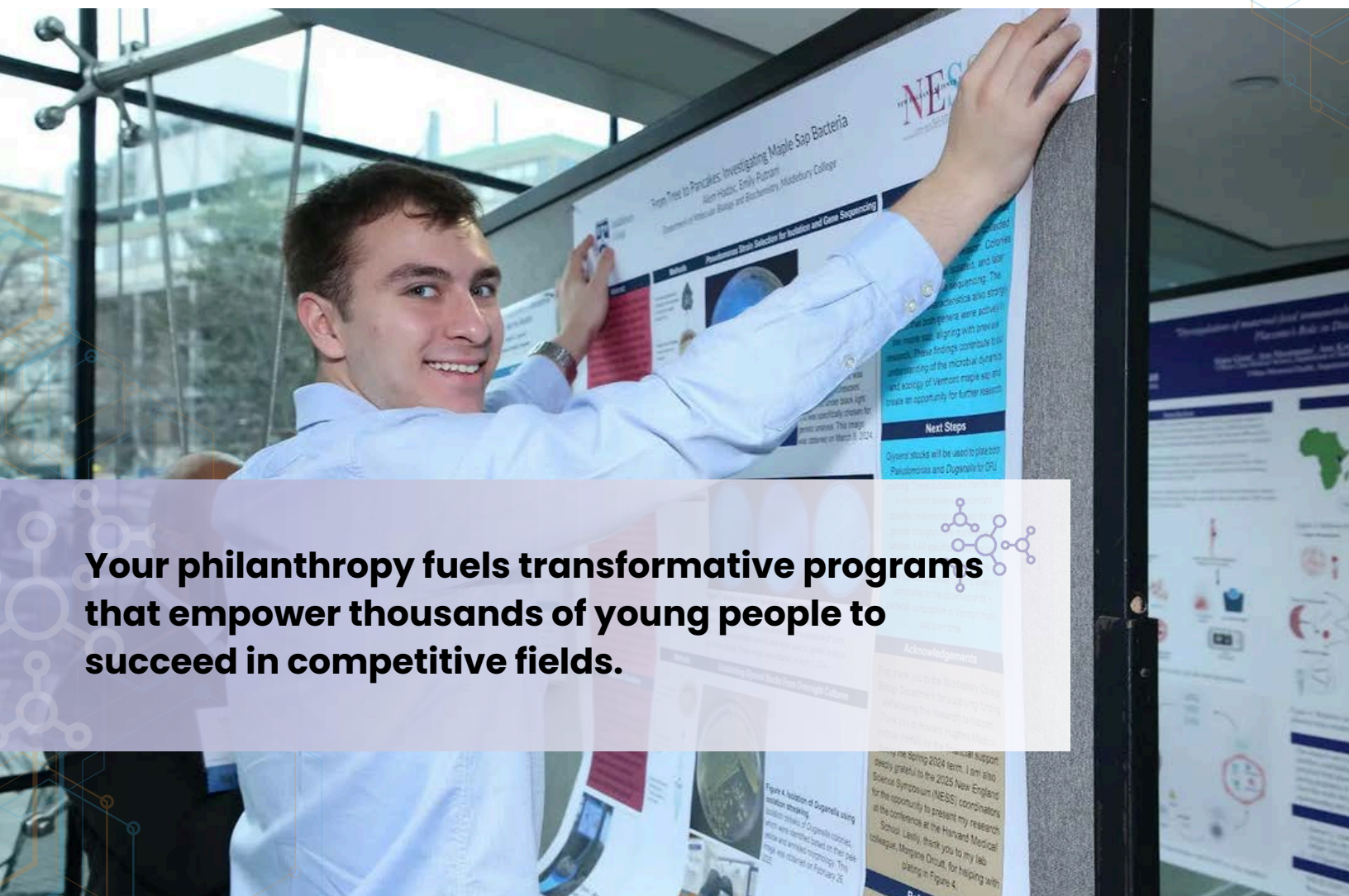
